## Homestay Pay

Good news! From the end of this month, there will be \$15 per week extra in your homestay fees. This will begin with your payment on 27 January or 3 February, whichever week your payment falls due.

## Xtra

We have been having some problems with xtra email addresses. Xtra customers were asked to modify their settings a few months ago, and those who didn't may have lost their xtra address. Please check for our e-mails, and please remember to check your Junk Box periodically in case our emails start going there.

## Health and Safety

We are doing a lot of work to ensure we are fully compliant with the 2015 Health and Safety Legislation. Our commitments include ensuring our Homestays all have safety precautions in place.

All homestays are requested to have First Aid supplies, and all RELA students should know where these supplies are.

Also, an evacuation plan, and your students should know the plan and the family meeting place.

Please follow basic safety rules when driving RELA students, e.g., the driver is always correctly licensed, seatbelt rules are followed closely, and vehicles are correctly registered and warranted.

## And some reminders

Please remember that each student bedroom should have a desk, a chair and a reading lamp. This is part of your homestay contract.

If you are hosting for other schools, we do need to know please, when we ask you to have a student. When we send homestay profiles to our students and their parents, they must know exactly who will be in the home before they arrive.

More and more, students and their families are e-mailing you before they arrive. It is very nice to set up this kind of communication if you can. And if you receive a message from a new student, please reply!
