NIGHT MARKET (Rules)

Students over 18 may do what you wish. If you are living in a RELA homestay, always make sure your homestay knows your plans, especially for meals.

Students aged 14-17 may go to the night market if your homestay agrees. You must make these plans with your homestay the day before, or in the morning before coming to school, and not annoy your homestay by texting and changing your plan often. Your pick-up time from the night market should be no later than 6.30pm.

Students under 14 may go to the night market with your homestay. If your homestay is not with you, you may go **ONLY** if you are with a student aged 14 or over who is willing to look after you. You must also have permission from the school and from your homestay.
