Fill The Bus will happen on Wednesday 2 December, and we will need your help.

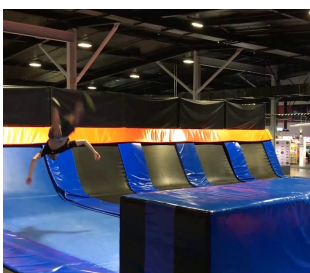
All over the world, people are donating to Food Banks. Rotorua has a Food Bank, and they urgently need donations of non-perishable food-cans, rice, packet food etc.
