Workshop: “Meet the Maker” at The Art Village

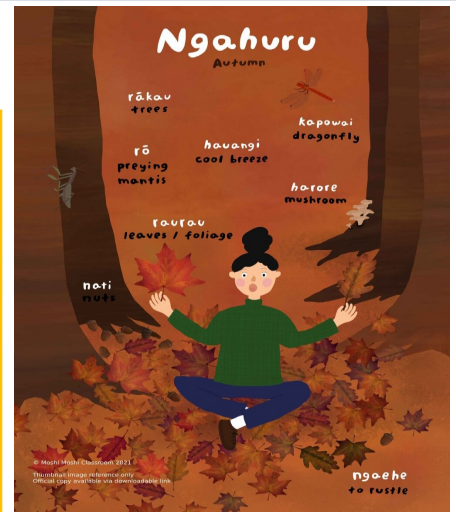
This session gives you a chance to meet the wonderful creative members in person and learn a bit more about how they make their pieces.

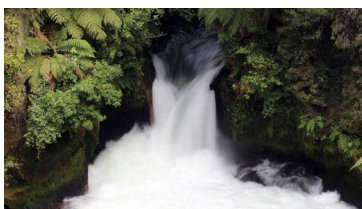
