Crankworx Rotorua (11–15 March)

Crankworx is one of the world's biggest **mountain biking festivals**, bringing top riders from around the world to compete in exciting events like **downhill racing, slopestyle jumps and pump track competitions.**

The event takes place at **Skyline Rotorua** and has a fun festival atmosphere with spectators watching incredible tricks and races.

Some days during the week are **free Local's Days**, but you usually need to **register online in advance.** It's a great chance to see world-class mountain biking here in Rotorua.



Te Arawa Kapa Haka Regionals (13–14 March)

Kapa haka is a traditional **Māori performing art** that combines **song (waiata), haka, chanting and coordinated movement** to share stories about Māori culture and history.

The **Te Arawa Regional Kapa Haka Competition** will take place on **13–14 March at Rotorua International Stadium.** Local kapa haka groups will perform and compete to qualify for the national **Te Matatini** festival.

Tickets are available online through **Ticketmaster.** This is a great chance to experience **authentic Māori culture and performance** in Rotorua.
